**Course Information** Further develops scuba diving skills and introduces new material to the certified diver. Develops night diving, navigation, deep diving, search and recovery and underwater environments or specialty training in one area. Students must be SCUBA certified before taking course. This course results in a PADI Advanced certification or specialty rating. Students are required to supply their own SCUBA mask, and this will be covered during the first class session.

### Gear Information:
