Course Information Covers necessary skills, physical conditioning and knowledge for the exciting sport of scuba diving. Diving skills such as hand signals, buoyancy control, equipment usage and diver safety will also be stressed. This course results in a PADI OpenWater certification. Students are required to supply their own SCUBA mask, and this will be covered during the first class session.

Text **PADI Open Water Crew Pack**– Student purchases the book at the LCC Bookstore, if you find one used, it needs to have the ‘knowledge reviews’ still in the manual, and an emlRDP.

PADI Go Dive DVD – Each student needs to view these DVDs. You may share them as needed.

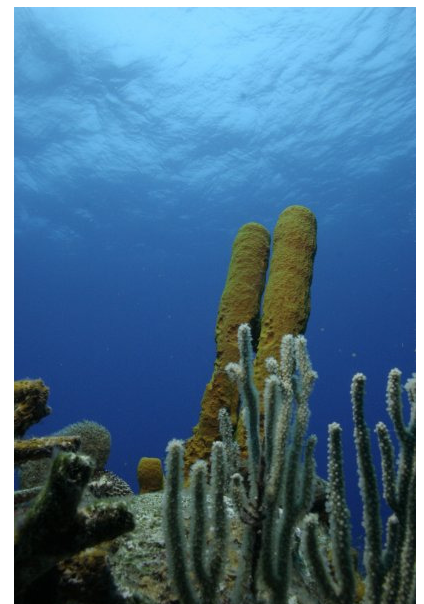
Gear Information

All students are required to supply their own SCUBA mask, covered during first classroom. All other equipment for the course is provided. You will need to stop by Eugene Skin Divers Supply to size up the equipment for the weekend outing. This needs to be done on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday before **week 4**. You will then drop by and pickup this gear for your weekend the Friday before your weekend. The gear must be returned on the following Monday.

Open Water Weekend: November 7th – 9th (Washington)

We will be staying at Mikes Beach Resort. Mikes Beach resort is located 20 minutes north of Hoodport Washington on HWY 101.
